Project Description (Proposed actions, location, and/or consequences).

The Beaumont Unified School District (District) is planning a number of improvements to the Anna M Hause Elementary School campus, which include the construction of new classroom buildings for the Beaumont Early Childhood Education Center, including new play areas, a lunch shelter, a new bus drop off and pick-up zone, various parking areas, a solar photovoltaic (PV) structure in parking lot 2, and circulation improvements that will serve the entire campus. The Beaumont Early Childhood Education Center would include two single-story buildings that would house the classrooms (total of eight), work rooms, offices, a conference room, a staff lounge, a nurse's office, a laundry room, restrooms, and storage and custodial rooms. Other project components include amenities and play areas; vehicular access, circulation, and parking improvements; and pedestrian access and circulation improvements.

The proposed project has the potential to result in significant impacts to Cultural Resources, Biological Resources, and Geology and Soils. However through implementation of mitigation measures BIO-1, CUL-1, CUL-2, and GEO-1 all impacts would be reduced less than significant.
