Project Title: Lantern Farms of Mendocino (Project)

Project Location: The Project is located at 52200 North Highway 101, unincorporated Mendocino County, CA, 95454.

County: Mendocino County

Project Description: The Department of Cannabis Control, pursuant to authority granted under Business and Profession Code, Section 26012, approved a Small Outdoor commercial cannabis license submitted on 02/11/2026, by Lantern Farms of Mendocino.

Project Activities: The project consists of 9,812 square feet of Small Outdoor cannabis cultivation. The water source is an onsite rainwater catchment pond that has an estimated storage capacity of 1,000,000 gallons. No construction or modifications to existing buildings are proposed as the application is seeking to replace an existing DCC Small Mixed-Light Tier 1 license, CCL21-0004579.
