**Project Title:** Lucerne Harbor Floats (Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. LAK-63785-R2)

**Project Location:** The project is located on Clear Lake, in the County of Lake, State of California. Latitude: 39.09048, longitude -122.79682 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees), 6216 E. Highway 20, Lucerne, CA 95458; Assessor's Parcel Number 034-121-011-000.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number LAK-63785-R2, pursuant to Section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Lake County Public Works, as represented by Lars Ewing.

The project is limited to the installation of two 8-foot by 40-foot floating docks and two 8-inch diameter pilings. The floats will be attached to an existing dock structure and will be secured by the newly installed pilings. The two new 8-inch diameter pilings will be installed using a free-fall hammer on a steel barge. No trees or vegetation will be removed for this project.
