Project Description: The project authorizes installation of a portable skid-mounted asphalt rubber blending plant to be temporarily located at CalPortland Garey Asphalt plant from year to year. Trucks deliver rubber contained in sacks which are emptied into the weigh hopper. The rubber is moved from the weigh hopper by a covered conveyor to the mixer where it is blended with paving asphalt that was received from the asphalt storage tank. In the mixer, oil and rubber are heated to 375F. The asphalt rubber blend is stored in a 30,000 gallon rubber storage tank prior to being sent to CalPortland's asphalt/concrete mixing plant. The primary and secondary 30,000 gallon storage tanks are heated by two propane-fired burners rated at 1.999 MMBtu/hr and 2.700 MMBtu/hr. The plant operates on grid power.

Reasons Why Project is Exempt:

The proposed project authorized under this permit is exempt from the requirements of the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") pursuant to Section 15061(b)(3) of the CEQA Guidelines because it can be seen with certainty that there is no possibility that the project may have a significant adverse effect on the environment. The proposed project is essentially a replacement of an existing portable skid-mounted asphalt rubber blending plant owned and operated by National Blending Company that has been operating at the site since 2012 up until recently when PTO 13905 was cancelled on April 7, 2026. The subject owner/operator, FNF AC, LLC, proposes operating a similar asphalt rubber blending plant in the same manner, with the plant located onsite on a temporary, as-needed basis from year to year. Therefore, the project results in negligible to no change from baseline conditions and is not an expansion of use beyond that previously existing. The proposed source will be located on the same site as the previous asphalt rubber plant and will have substantially the same purpose and capacity as the former plant.
