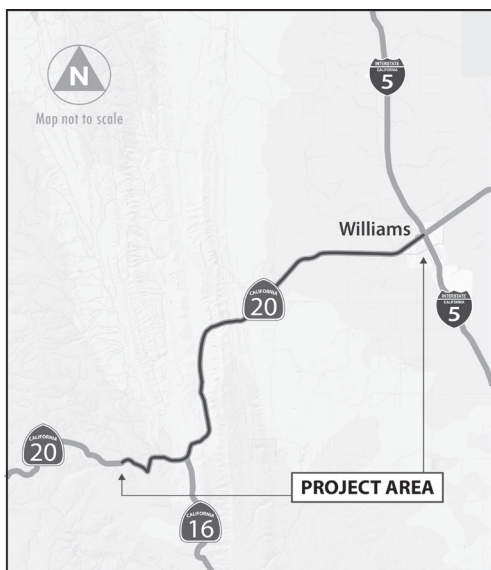
NOTICE OF PREPARATION & VIRTUAL PUBLIC MEETING STATE ROUTE 20 SAFETY IMPROVEMENTS PROJECT

WHAT IS PLANNED:

The California Department of Transportation proposes a safety improvements project in Colusa County on State Route 20 extending from the Colusa/Lake County line, Postmile (PM) 0.0 to Interstate 5 Intersection, PM R22.1. The project scope includes shoulders widening between PM 10.4 – PM 11.8, enhancing drainage, implementing rumble strips, upgrading guardrails, and improving signage and striping.

WHY THIS PUBLIC NOTICE:

Caltrans wants input from the public, resource agencies, and stakeholders. A virtual public scoping meeting will provide project information and an opportunity to provide comments. Caltrans will consider comments in the environmental document and in defining the project scope.
