Project Title: Five Cities Multitmodal Transportation Network Enhancement Project (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SLO-52422-R4).

Project Location: The Project is located at Pismo Creek along United States Highway (US) 101 at highway post mile 16.41, approximately 0.19 miles south of the Price Canyon Road overcrossing, in San Luis Obispo County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement number EPIMS-SLO-52422-R4, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, the California Department of Transportation. The Project includes activities related to bridge column installation, sheet pile wall installation, placement of rock slope protection, and restoration of the stream.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as the Responsible Agency, approved the above-described project on 2/9/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Final Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
