Project Title: 7th Street Channel Improvements, Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-RIV-63189-R6

Project Location (Riverside County): The 7th Street Channel Improvements (Project) is located at San Jacinto Creek in the County of Riverside County State of California; Latitude 33.7760, Longitude -117.2050. The proposed improvements to the 7th Street channel are located west of the I-215 freeway, between Ellis Avenue and 7th Street. The Project is located within Assessor's Parcel Number [APN] 310-170-017.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-RIV-63189-R6), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, for the Project Applicant IDI Logistics (Permittee) or as represented by Brian Caris.


The proposed Project is limited to the installation of a new outfall structure; implementing ongoing maintenance activities including the removal of sand, silt, sediment, debris, and other obstructions to flow within the channel and near the new outfall structure; control of weeds, grasses, woody vegetation, and emergent aquatic vegetation; grading to address issues with standing or stagnant water for vector control; and repair of failed portions of the new outfall structure, associated rip rap, or channel sections impacted by any outfall structure failure.
