Project Title: Culvert Replacement and Maintenance Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-TRI-51091-R1)

Project Location (Trinity): 1330 Brady Road, Hayfork, CA, 96041. Trinity County APN 014-290-032-000. Latitude 40.571939, Longitude -123.173479.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-TRI-51091-R1), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Thayeng Vang.

Project is limited to the replacement of one 18" CMP culvert with a 24" CMP culvert and the armoring of both the inlet and outlet with ¾" rock.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on July 18th, 2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
