
**Project Title:** Her Stormwater and Stream Crossing Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. [EPIMS-TRI-64742-R1C])

**Project Location (Trinity):** The Project to be completed is located within the Lamb Creek, Mad River watershed, approximately 1.32 miles northeast of the town of Mad River, County of Trinity, State of California. The Project is located in Section 15, T1N, R6E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Sportshaven U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor's Parcel Number 018-040-001-000; latitude 40.4663 N and longitude 123.4870 W.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement ([EPIMS-TRI-64742-R1C]), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, Chang Her. The Project is limited to one encroachment. The encroachment is for the decommissioning of a culverted stream crossing and the realignment and restoration of a stream channel. This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on April 13, 2026, and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Environmental Impact Report** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were not** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were not** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
