**Project Title:** East Cypress Road Widening Project (CIP 302 & 310) (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-CCA-57357-R3)

**Project Location (Contra Costa County):** The Project is located at an unnamed tributary to Little Dutch Slough, in the County of Contra Costa, State of California; Latitude 37.99147°, Longitude -121.65934°; Assessor's Parcel Number 032-270-822-0.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-CCA-57357-R3), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, to the project Applicant, the City of Oakley.

The Project is limited to the clearing, cut, and fill necessary to expand the roadway within two connected perennial wetlands and one unnamed tributary to Little Dutch Slough. Existing pavement will be sawcut and removed adjacent to these features. The wetland and riparian areas will be cleared and grubbed of vegetation, leveled to the new design grade, and paved. In preparation for this Project, removal of two California black walnut and three Goodding's black willows occurred along the unnamed tributary to Little Dutch Slough.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on August 12, 2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Final EIR prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
