Project Title: Victorville Sanitary Landfill Phase 2 Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-SBR-63283-R6)

Project Location (San Bernardino County): The Victorville Sanitary Landfill Phase 2 Project (Project) is located at 18600 Stoddard Wells Road, Victorville, California 92395, approximately 7 miles north of the intersection of Interstate 15 and State Highway 18 within San Bernardino County. The Project is located at Assessor's Parcel Number 0472-011-34 at latitude 34.59939.94 and longitude -117.261970.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. EPIMS-SBR-63283-R6, pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602 to County of San Bernardino.

This proposed Project involves the development of 107 acres of undisturbed land for the Phase 2 of the Victorville Sanitary Landfill. Project Activities include grading, removal of vegetation, and clearing the Project site using dozers, scrapers, and water trucks.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the Project described above on May 4, 2026, and has made the following determinations regarding the Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

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1. The Project **will not** have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this Project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW's approval of the Project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was** adopted by CDFW for this Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations **was not** adopted by CDFW for this Project.
6. Findings **were** made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The Final EIR prepared for the Project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of project approval as a Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
