The Climate Compass is a comprehensive update to the City of Elk Grove's current Climate Action Plan (CAP), adopted in 2019. The Climate Compass establishes a roadmap for the City of Elk Grove to achieve its greenhouse gas (GHG) emission reduction targets and includes actions and strategies to adapt to anticipated climate-related impacts. In addition, the Climate Compass aligns local efforts with Assembly Bill 1279 (2021-22 Legislative Session), which requires California to achieve net-zero GHG emissions and an 85 percent reduction in anthropogenic GHG emissions by 2045.
