Project Title: Haines Road at Wise Canal Bridge Replacement (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. PLA-51475-R2)

Project Location (include county): The project is located at an unnamed tributary to Dry Creek, in the County of Placer, State of California; Latitude 38.950588, Longitude -121.051909 - 121.052357 (WGS 84 datum, decimal degrees). The project site is located at the existing Haines Road Bridge crossing of the Wise Canal, northeast of the City of Auburn in unincorporated Placer County.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number PLA-51475-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Placer County Department of Public Works as represented by Kyle Friedrich.

Project activities are limited to the replacement and widening of an existing 5.25-ft tall, 3.8-ft wide, 33-ft long box culvert within the road prism on the north side of the bridge location that conveys an unnamed perennial tributary to Dry Creek. The new box culvert will be 8-ft tall, 4-ft wide, 48-ft long, and includes 55 cubic yards of rock slope protection in the 594 sq ft outfall area. In addition to the widened and replaced box culvert, an unlined drainage ditch will be constructed between the rock slope protection and overside drain installed on the north side of the road.


This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.

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2. CDFW considered the mitigated negative declaration prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The mitigated negative declaration prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the above Streambed Alteration Agreement as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
