Project Title: Folsom Plan Area Specific Plan (Master Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification No. 1600-2012-0198-R2) Extension

Project Location (include county): The project is located south of Highway 50, north of White Rock Road, east of Prairie City Road, and west of the El Dorado County line, in Sacramento County, California.

Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed an Extension to Master Streambed Alteration Agreement Notification Number 1600-2012-0198-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, Folsom South Area Group.

This Extension extends the Master Streambed Alteration Agreement expiration from February 11, 2026 to February 11, 2031. All other conditions in the original Master Streambed Alteration Agreement remain in effect.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Master Streambed Alteration Agreement Extension on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
