Project Title: San Luis Obispo Urban Stream Routine Maintenance (Streambed Alteration Agreement No. 1600-2018-0028-R4)

Project Location: The Project will occur at 14 specific maintenance project sites in Prefumo Creek, Four unnamed Tributaries to Acacia Creek, San Luis Obispo Creek, San Luis Obispo Creek Bypass Channel, Sydney Creek, and Old Garden Creek, within the limits of the City of San Luis Obispo, San Luis Obispo County, California, within USGS 7.5 Minute Quadrangle Maps San Luis Obispo and Pismo Beach.


Project Description: The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Amendment No. 1 to Streambed Alteration Agreement no. 1600-2018-0028-R4, issued to the City of San Luis Obispo.

The Agreement authorizes annual reoccurring sediment removal and vegetation maintenance activities to facilitate storm water conveyance in multiple streams within the limits of the City of San Luis Obispo. Amendment No. 1 authorizes dewatering activities to facilitate sediment removal.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above on 2/23/2026 and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the Environmental Impact Report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan was adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
