Project Title: Nipomo Supplemental Water Project -Water Supply Permit Amendment Project (Project)

Project Applicant: Nipomo Community Services District

Project Location: Cross streets of Joshua Street and Orchard Road, Nipomo City, CA, 93444. San Luis Obispo County.

Project Description: The Applicant proposes the operation of three interconnections that will allow them to deliver supplemental water to the Golden State Water Company (GSWC) Nipomo service area, the GSWC Cypress Ridge service area, and the Woodlands Mutual Water company service area. Each interconnect includes a precast concrete vault, flow control valve, flowmeter, piping, valves, electrical and instrumentation control panel, and communication system.

This is to advise that the State Water Resources Control Board (Responsible Agency) has approved a water supply permit amendment for the above-described Project on 8/12/2025 and has made the following determinations regarding the above-described Project:

1. The Project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to the effects within the State Water Board's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. An Environmental Impact Report was prepared for this Project pursuant to the provisions of CEQA.
3. Mitigation measures were not made a condition of the State Water Board's approval of the Project.
4. A mitigation monitoring and reporting plan/program was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by the State Water Board for the Project.

6. Findings were made by the State Water Board pursuant to the California Code of Regulations Section 15091.
