Description of Previous Action: The City of San Diego previously prepared a Program Environmental Impact Report (PEIR) No. 30330/304032 / SCH No. 2004651076 for the Otay Mesa Community Plan Update. The PEIR was certified by the San Diego City Council on March 11, 2014, via Resolution No. R-308810. The Otay Mesa CPU involved an update to the Otay Mesa Community Plan, a General Plan Amendment, rescission of the Otay Mesa Development District (OMDD), adoption of a Rezone Ordinance to replace the OMDD with citywide zoning and creation of two new CPIOZs, amendments to the City's Land Development Code (LDC), and an update of the Otay Mesa Community Plan Public Facilities Financing Plan (PFFP).
