**Project Title:** Crossings at El Dorado (Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification No. ELD-51175-R2)

**Project Location (include county):** The project is located at two locations along Mound Springs Creek and US Hwy 50 and El Dorado Road, in the County of El Dorado, State of California; Location 1: Latitude 38.70984, Longitude -120.84609; Location 2: Latitude 38.71029, Longitude -120.84774.

**Project Description:** The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Streambed Alteration Agreement EPIMS Notification Number ELD-51175-R2, pursuant to section 1602 of the Fish and Game Code to the project Applicant, El Dorado RV Resort and Campground LLC.

The project is limited to the installation of two pairs of 48-inch storm drains in two separate locations within Mound Springs Creek. Campground driveways will be constructed over both locations with a width between 25 and 30 feet. Rock for erosion control will be installed at each inlet/outlet. At Location 1, approximately 20 by 20 feet of riprap will be installed at both the inlet and outlet. At Location 2, approximately 35 by 15 feet of riprap will be installed at the inlet and 15 by 15 feet at the outlet.


This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, executed the above Streambed Alteration Agreement on the date signed below and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW's permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the environmental impact report prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures were made a condition of CDFW's approval of the project.

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4. A mitigation reporting or monitoring plan was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A statement of overriding considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.

The final environmental impact report prepared for the project is available to the general public at the office location listed above for the Lead Agency. CDFW's record of execution of the above Streambed Alteration Agreement as Responsible Agency is available at CDFW's regional office.
