Project Title: Karachobanov Stream Crossings Project (Lake or Streambed Alteration Agreement No. EPIMS-HUM-55823-R1C)

Project Location (Humboldt County): The Project to be completed is located within the Mattole River watershed, approximately 3 miles northwest of the town of Briceland, County of Humboldt, State of California. The Project is located in Section 16, T4S, R2E, Humboldt Base and Meridian; in the Briceland U.S. Geological Survey 7.5-minute quadrangle; Assessor’s Parcel Number 220-041-002; latitude 40.1199 N and longitude 123.9578 W.

Project Description: The Project is limited to two encroachments to upgrade existing culverts at road/stream crossings. Work for these encroachments will include excavation, removal of the existing culverts, replacement with new properly sized culverts, backfilling and compaction of fill, and rock armoring as necessary to minimize erosion. The California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW) has executed Lake and Streambed Alteration Agreement (EPIMS-HUM-55823-R1C), pursuant to Fish and Game Code section 1602, the project Applicant, Petar Karachobanov.

This is to advise that CDFW, acting as a Responsible Agency, approved the project described above and has made the following determinations regarding the project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (i):

1. The project will not have a significant effect on the environment. This determination is limited to effects within CDFW’s permitting jurisdiction as a Responsible Agency.
2. CDFW considered the **Mitigated Negative Declaration** prepared by the Lead Agency for this project pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15096, subdivision (f).
3. Mitigation measures **were** made a condition of CDFW’s approval of the project.
4. A Mitigation Reporting or Monitoring Plan **was not** adopted by CDFW for this project.
5. A Statement of Overriding Considerations was not adopted by CDFW for this project.
6. Findings were not made by CDFW pursuant to California Code of Regulations section 15091.
